CLUB GRANTS PROGRAM: COACHING & UMPIRING

In 2023 in Victoria, clubs who achieve a 1:1 ratio of female umpires/coaches to Women's and Girl's teams will be eligible to apply for a Women and Girls Umpiring or Coaching grant.

9-A-SIDE FOOTBALL LAUNCHES!

AFL Victoria in partnership with Sporting Schools Victoria last month launched 9-a-side footy competitions across eight regional areas in Victoria. With six trials already delivered, there has been over 1180 participants in the one-day event playing the AFL's modified version of the game.

The trials included both girls and mixed teams and divisions with girls making up over 45% of participants so far.
