BE SAFE

Every one has the right to be safe on and off the field or court and online

RESPECTED

Everyone should be treated with respect no matter your race, colour, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, language, or religion



BE HEARD

Your experiences, ideas and opinions are important and should be heard



SPEAK UP

If something is wrong, speak up and tell a trusted adult to get help. If your concern isn't taken seriously speak to another trusted adult.
