

Netball Player Registration

All players and coaches must be registered to your club on both Netball Connect and PlayHQ. This is regardless of if they are playing for the season or just playing the one single match.

Netball Connect

A player first registers to your Club on Netball Connect where they will receive an eight-digit membership number. Each Club has its unique registration link to issue to their players which they must use to register.

If they have registered for a different competition previously in that calendar year, there is no charge involved and it adds your Club to their player profile.

If they have not registered in ours or any other competition in the current calendar year, they will be charged for the year membership, or they can purchase a single match voucher if they are just filling in for a single match.

A player can only purchase a maximum of four single match vouchers in any calendar year.

Why do they have to register to my Club on Netball Connect?

This provides or ensures that they hold current Netball Victoria membership and are covered by the NA National Insurance Scheme. This is protection for your club should a serious injury be sustained.

PlayHQ Registration

A player will then register to your Club on PlayHQ and enter their Netball Connect membership number when requested.

On both platforms it is vital that they use the same login details as in previous years if re-registering or they will create a duplicate record.

If a player is only playing the single game, we can provide a discount voucher for that registration.

Why do they have to register to my Club on PlayHQ? So, you can select them in your teams, securely knowing that they are not currently registered with another Club within the competition.

What is the penalty for playing an unregistered player?

The current penalty is a \$500.00 and a potential loss of premiership points.
