



Position Description - OEFN Junior Interleague Coaching Director

Overview

The Coaching Director is responsible for overseeing the development, coordination, and delivery of the coaching program across the OEFN Interleague Program October - June. This role focuses on supporting coaches, ensuring alignment with the Eastern Ranges model, and contributing to player and coach development through structured training, communication, and evaluation.

Key Responsibilities

1. Coach Support & Development

- Work closely with all Interleague coaches to provide guidance, mentorship, and ongoing support.
- Offer feedback to coaches throughout the program to enhance coaching practice and player development.
- Assist with coach correspondence, ensuring clear and timely communication.

2. Program Implementation

- Collaborate with Eastern Ranges staff to replicate and integrate their coaching programs, philosophies, and development frameworks into our program.
- Attend regular training sessions to assist coaches with effective implementation of the Interleague program and training standards.

3. Team Selection & Trials

- Participate in the player selection process for all sides.
- Assist in planning, coordinating, and setting up all trial games, including communicating expectations to coaches and support staff.

4. Game & Event Attendance

- Attend and observe games during the King's Birthday Weekend Carnival and other key events.
- Provide post-game feedback to coaches based on observations of team performance and program adherence.
- Attend and help at our Interleague Jumper Presentation days.

5. Administration & Communication

- Support the coaching group with administrative duties, including scheduling, program documentation, and communication of updates.
- Work collaboratively with the program leadership to ensure consistency and alignment between coaching, player development, and the program objectives.

Key Skills & Attributes

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to mentor and support coaches at various levels (U13 Boys, U14 Boys, U15 Boys, U14 Girls & U16 Girls).
- Understanding of modern coaching methodologies and development pathways.
- Organisational skills and the ability to manage multiple responsibilities.
- Alignment with the OEFN Interleague values and commitment to player development.

Reporting

The Coaching Director reports directly to the **OEFN Junior Operations Coordinator** and works in partnership with the coaches of all the OEFN Interleague teams for the duration of the program.

As this is primarily a Volunteer role, an Honorarium payment is available to the successful applicant.
